Mr Anderson reported that the day was a success and although some mistakes had been made that most local organizations had been pleased with their takings Mr Anderson, also reported the Friends wished to have an event next year and on the proposal of Mr Stebbing and seconded by Mr Watson to agree to this request, after a vote of 3-3 the Chairman gave his casting vote to approve the proposal. The Insurance element of £78-75 was to be paid from the Council's Insurance Budget on the proposal of the Chairman and was agreed by all.

4.5 State of Goalposts

It had been reported by the Handyman to the Clerk that in the opinion of the Groundsman that three sets of goalposts should be renewed as they were getting worn. It was decided the Clerk should take further advice and report back.

4.6 New Notices re No Animals on KGV

Some people had been observed taking dogs on the KGV, which notices had said it was not allowed. It was decided to revamp the notices already up to make it clearer of the prohibition

4.7 Replacement Concrete Posts at KGV

It was decided to hold this in abeyance till the Car Park had been sorted out.

4.8 Longdale Tennis Court update

The Chairman would liaise with the Clerk to take the next step forward on the Grant Application.

5 **Exchange of Information.**

Mr Stebbing reported that the roundabout at the Florence Carter play area did need some adjustment, but it did not need to be stopped the use of. The Clerk reported that as per Inspection carried out by Norse; there were mainly adjustments and repainting to be carried out on the Florence Carter, which the Handyman hoped to carry out in the next fortnight. The KGV and Longdale equipment had no substantial faults pointed out. Mr Thompson queried the erection of Boot Cleaners near to both Pavilions and a concrete pad, which would be discussed at a later date.
