



**5. Exchange of Information**

Mr Wilkinson reported on the Airport Consultative Committee he had attended during the week. The main topic of conversation was excessive helicopter activity and it had brought about a robust discussion. Drayton Parishioners had complained to Mr Wilkinson, so he reported their views to the meeting. At the meeting, also, the Managing Director of the airport reported that due to the closure of the Caister Heliport that from May 2011 there would be an increase of 50% more helicopter flights, as the companies were transferring to Norwich. Since the meeting, another parishioner had contacted Mr Wilkinson and he had replied. Mr Wilkinson said he would continue to chase the Airport about this ongoing problem. From the meeting, it was learnt one company had breached the operating hours 9 times out of 12. The Managing director stated, there was a big possibility this company would not use Norwich, next year.

Mr K Morgan reported he had spoken to the Best Kept Front Garden judge from this year and he suggested it may be advisable for the winner of each year's best kept garden becomes one of the judges the following year. This will be put on the agenda for a future meeting. Mr Morgan had also been approached by somebody requesting there being a Public Toilet in Drayton. It was reported that the Bob Carter Centre could be used.

Mr Thompson had been approached concerning the village having Christmas lights next year. It was agreed to support this suggestion and advertise the idea in a future Chronicle.
