4. General Matters

4.1 Printing Costs

The Chairman had obtained two quotes for printing to check the market. The quotes from both Colour Print and Norwich Colourprint are attached to these minutes. It was decided to discuss at next sub-Committee Meeting, future plans. For now, it was decided to keep with Colour Print till the next advertising yearly amounts become due.

4.2 Cost of Advertising

The future costing of advertising will be discussed nearer the time, the renewals become due.

4.3 Future Content

He urged Committee members to bring more articles for the publications and thus, there would be more to read for the Parishioners. The question of extra pages would be discussed at the forthcoming sub-committee meetings.

Mr Stebbing that there should be no articles by the serving District Councillors before next year's elections. This was carried by 3 votes to 1.
4.5 Budget 2011-2012

The Clerk had prepared a draft budget, which is attached to these minutes. After a lot of discussion, on the proposal; of Mr Stebbing and seconded by Mr Watson that due to the uncertainty of how advertising revenues, were for next year, that the full amount of £5405 be sent to the Finance Committee for the budget requirement. This was agreed by all to be sent to Finance for approval.

Mr Anderson left the meeting at 19.20 hours, before the proposal of the figures and as he left he stated the Financial Committee will not accept the draft figures prepared.

5. Exchange of Information

Mr Stebbing queried the information of the Broadland Bus, and as there was uncertainty about its running's, it was decided to delete the information from the next Chronicle.

Mr Watson queried if there was any pictures of the Glider crash, as per the new edition of the Chronicle.
