7. General Matters

7.1 Advertising

Mr Thompson advised members that if the present trend of advertising continues, it could raise £4620 this year. This could in fact cut the cost to about £580 per year for the magazine after the cost of printing and delivery. Mr Thompson thought that the cost to advertisers should remain as it is and proposed this from the chair. All

members were in favour. Mr Lamb suggested putting in the next magazine about the costing of advertising being the same for the last three years.

7.2 Future Meetings

Mr Thompson reported that it was proposed to hold quarterly meetings instead of monthly. The next meeting to be held at the Bob Carter Centre on the 15th June at 7 p.m.

7.3 Future Editions

Mr Lamb said he would like to organise in future magazines Thorpe Marriott Life, a Web site which gives information of events in Thorpe Marriott, Drayton and Taverham be brought to parishioner's attention. . It was agreed to try to put in at no cost. Mr Thompson reported the designer felt the magazine should read as Quarterly Editions Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter, this was felt to be a good idea. It was agreed that there should be Clerk's report to feature in future editions.
